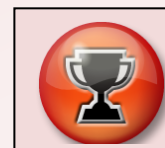

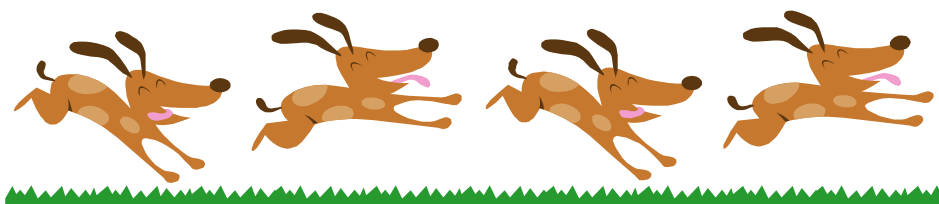

Gleniffer Flyball are holding a charity Race Night at Strathclyde Police Recreation Association's Lochinch Social Club, Pollok Park, Glasgow to raise funds for the teams forthcoming trip to compete at Crufts 2013.

There is limited availability of 48 horses in total (6 races x 8 horses per race) and these can be purchased for £3 each from members of the Flyball Team.
