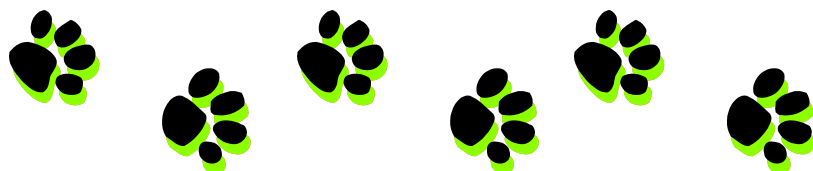




## June 2011 Newsletter

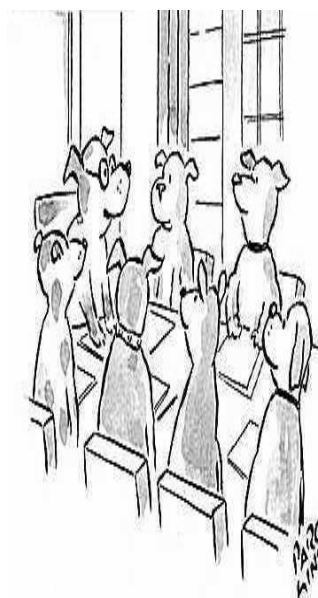

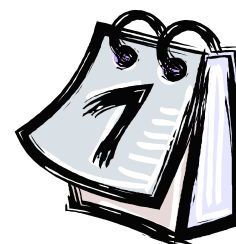

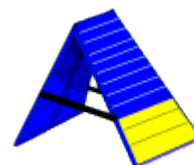
