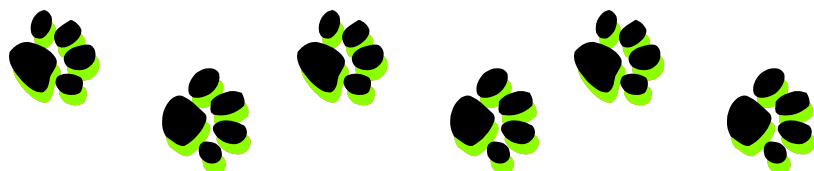

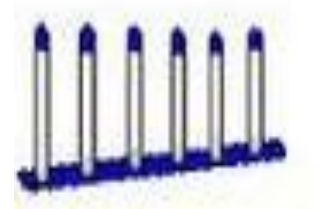
Could I please ask any members who are interested in booking a place to contact me ASAP, that then gives me plenty of time to fill any remaining spaces with non members.

Winter Training
